Mr. Mamrak moved and Mrs. Moyle seconded the motion to approve two students and one chaperone to participate in the Skills USA National competition in Louisville, Kentucky in June 2019. The motion carried 5-0.

Mrs. Moyle moved and Mr. Mamrak seconded the motion to approve the first reading of LycoCTC policy 136, Closing of Programs, with revisions, as presented. Then motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Whitmoyer moved and Mr. Mamrak seconded the motion to improve employee agreement between Lyco and Eric Butler that runs through June 30, 2021. The motion carried 5-0.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

Curriculum/Programs/Enrollment:

Mr. Butler discussed the senior post graduation data. There has been more of a trend in the last few years of graduates excepting full time positions. Normally we have about 60 percent going to college. Another big change is the increase in students going into the military. Overall, most graduating seniors of them want to stay in the general area.

Mr. Butler reviewed the recruitment data. This year, we have had interaction with over 1000 students, grades sixth-ninth.

We conducted interviews at the beginning of the month and our student of the year has been selected; Brianna Girardi is an Early Childhood student from East Lycoming. She will be giving a speech at Lyco's senior ceremony on May 22nd.

Our last student day will be Wednesday, June 5th and the last teacher in-service day will be on the 6th.

Communications/ Public Relations:

Our annual mentor luncheon was held last week. This year we also did signing ceremonies for the students who will be continuing on in full time positions with their mentor companies after graduation. Of the thirteen co-op students, six received full time offers.

On Monday, May 20th, we will be having a memorial tree planting ceremony to honor Jeff Meck, our late computer instructor, who passed away suddenly last summer. Mr. Meck's family, students, and staff will be present. Mr. Butler invited all board members to come as well.

Representatives from the local Ciocca car dealerships will be coming to meet with Mr. Kline and Mr. Butler about a potential future partnership. We are hopeful that this will lead to more job opportunities for our students.
